Here are some of the things we did in third grade this week:

In religion, we had Reconciliation on Tuesday afternoon with Fr. Jerry and Fr. Matthew. During Lent, one thing we do is to ask for forgiveness. We also began learning how the church celebrates the sacraments. We learned that Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist are the sacraments of Christian Initiation. We have included all those who will be receiving those sacraments for the first time in our daily prayers.

In math, we began our chapter on time. We have been learning about telling time to the minute, deciding if it should be A.M. or P.M. and finding elapsed time. We will continue with elapsed time and different strategies into next week. We will also learn about measuring length in this chapter.

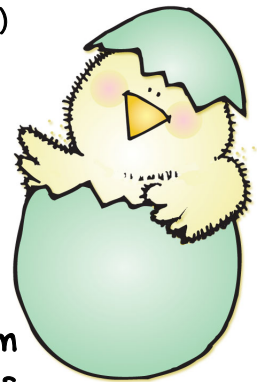

We loved being introduced to all the farm animals and enjoyed reading of how the goose shows Wilbur how to escape through the fence. Our spelling pattern for the week was words with prefixes. We also worked on comparative and superlative adjectives.
