

We had a great and busy start to May in third grade. Thank you, and your children, for a wonderful Teacher Appreciation Week! You know how to make the teachers feel so loved and special!

Here are some of the things we did in third grade this week:

In religion, we began discussing that the Mass is a sacrifice and a meal and how we take part in the Mass. The Mass is a celebration and it is the Church's great prayer for thanksgiving and praise. We celebrate Mass each week on Sunday because it is the day on which Jesus rose from the dead.

In math, we have been working on finding area. We learned about counting the boxes, using repeated addition and multiplication. We also discussed using area to compare rectangles with the same perimeter in addition to using perimeter to compare rectangles with the same area. Next week we will begin

our unit on division and that will take us through the end of the school year!

Since our chicks went to a local farm, we have finished our unit on embryology. We took a break this week and worked on several lessons on Common Sense Media — which is about digital citizenship. It helps students to think critically, behave safely, and participate responsibly in our digital world. We discussed the kinds of responsibilities a good digital citizen has, how we can protect ourselves from online identity theft and what to do when someone uses mean or scary language on the Internet.

In language arts, we have continued our novel study on <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. We have seen Charlotte's plan start to go in place as she is trying to save Wilbur. She used her web to show the gullible <u>Zuckermans</u> how Wilbur is a unique pig and wrote "Some Pig" in her web. Will her plan work? Our spelling pattern for the week was words with accent syllables.
