We had another busy and wonderful week in third grade! We were excited to make it to the Fremont Township Garden on Tuesday afternoon. Here are some of the things we did in third grade this week:

In math, we have been working hard on our division unit! This week we learned how we could model a division problem to find how many equal groups. We learned the names of the numbers in a division problem (dividend,

In science we have been learning how living things have common features. We discussed how living things grow and change. We learned how plants and animals react and respond to their environment.

In language arts, we have continued our novel study on <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. This week we have worked on chapters 13, 14, and 15. The humans and the animals on the farm notice the crickets are singing and they take it as a sign that summer is coming to an end. Our spelling pattern for the week were words that double the final consonant when adding an ending along with comparatives and superlatives.
