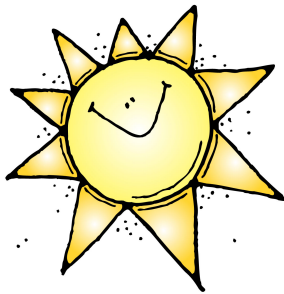


# SUMMER
